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At Flatland Psychiatry, we are committed to providing the highest standard of care tailored to the individual needs of our patients. As part of our ongoing efforts to prioritize both patient well-being and compliance with state regulations, we would like to inform you of our policy regarding controlled substances.

In accordance with Texas State Law physician assistants (PAs) are not permitted to prescribe Schedule II medications. In addition, our practice philosophy does not support the prescription or use of controlled substances for the treatment of psychiatric conditions.

Controlled medications, including those commonly prescribed for attention deficit disorder, panic disorders, and other psychiatric conditions, are not part of the treatment options we offer. Some examples of medications that we do not prescribe include, but are not limited to: *Adderall, Ritalin, Xanax, Vyvanse, Ativan, Valium, Clonazepam, Lunesta, Ambien, Lyrica, etc.*

We understand that this policy may cause inconvenience, and we sincerely apologize for any difficulties it may create. Please know that we are fully committed to providing effective alternative treatments and support to help manage your health and well-being.
